## INVITATION TO ATTEND THE INTERIM WORLD SERVICE CONFERENCE 2024 AS OBSERVERS

All Nar-Anon members are invited to attend the Nar-Anon Interim World Service Conference (IWSC) 2024 as observers. Click this link to register for the Zoom Webinar.

Once you complete the registration, a Zoom link will be emailed to you. The link you receive will be uniquely created for you and will not work if you share it with another member. If another member also wants to observe, help them to sign up so they can receive their own unique link.

We suggest saving the Zoom link email in a way that you can easily find and use during the IWSC 2024. The email that contains the link will also include contact information should you need assistance.

The IWSC 2024 sessions will begin at 6:00 am PDT on Friday April 19, Saturday April 20, and Sunday April 21, 2024. This link will help you convert that time to your local time.

The IWSC 2024 uses Zoom webinar, which is a different Zoom format than what you experience when attending a Nar-Anon meeting. When you attend as an observer you can see and hear the IWSC 2024, but no one will see or hear you. In other words, observers are not able to interact with the participants of the IWSC.

We have found it is best to use a computer. It is possible to use a tablet or cell phone, but you will have a more limited view than you would with a computer. With a computer, you will see what the Zoom host sees. With a tablet or cell phone, your device may change views as it tries to follow the activity.

The IWSC 2024 is a multilingual event. We are using Zoom Translated Captions (ZTC) to convert what is spoken into text in the language you choose. You can access ZTC by selecting the option to "Show Captions." When you click on that option, Zoom should ask you to select the language you want to see. You need only set this option once based on what language you want to read. Zoom will automatically translate what is spoken into the language you selected. If the captions are moving too quickly, you can choose the option to "View Full Transcript." On a computer, the full transcript will appear in a separate window. On a tablet or cell phone, the transcript will probably fill your screen and block your view of the other parts of the IWSC.
